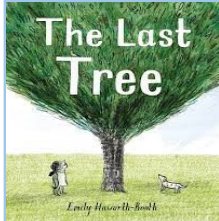
# Sharing the Planet

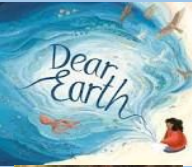

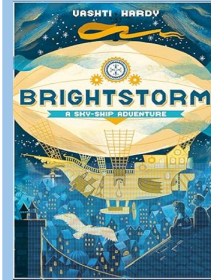
